

Terms of Use for Online Shop

These Terms of Use (hereinafter referred to as 'Terms') set forth the conditions for using the online shop (hereinafter referred to as 'Service') provided by MS-OPTICS Co., Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as 'Company') on this website. Registered users (hereinafter referred to as 'Users') shall use the Service in accordance with these Terms.

Article 1 (Application)

1. These Terms shall apply to all relationships related to the use of the Service between the User and the Company.
2. In addition to these Terms, the Company may establish rules and other provisions (hereinafter referred to as 'Individual Provisions') regarding the use of the Service. These Individual Provisions shall constitute part of these Terms regardless of their name.
3. If the provisions of these Terms conflict with the Individual Provisions, the Individual Provisions shall prevail unless otherwise specified.

Article 2 (User Registration)

1. Registration shall be completed when an applicant agrees to these Terms, applies for registration in the manner prescribed by the Company, and the Company notifies the applicant of its approval.
2. The Company may refuse registration if it determines that the applicant falls under any of the following, and shall not be obligated to disclose the reasons:
 - False information was provided during registration.
 - The applicant has previously violated these Terms.
 - The Company deems the registration inappropriate.

Article 3 (Management of User ID and Password)

Users shall manage their User ID and password at their own responsibility. They must not transfer, lend, or share them with third parties. If the combination of User ID and password matches the registered information and login occurs, the Company will regard it as use by the registered User. The Company shall not be liable for any damage caused by third-party use unless due to intentional or gross negligence by the Company.

Article 4 (Sales Contract)

A sales contract is established when the User applies for purchase and the Company notifies acceptance. Ownership of the product transfers to the User when the Company hands it over to the delivery service. The Company may cancel the contract without prior notice if:

- The User violates these Terms.
- Delivery cannot be completed due to unknown address or prolonged absence.
- Trust between the Company and User is deemed impaired.

Payment, delivery, cancellation, and return methods shall follow the Company's separate provisions.

Article 5 (Intellectual Property Rights)

Copyrights and other intellectual property rights of product photos and other content provided through the Service belong to the Company or rightful owners. Users may not reproduce, reprint, modify, or otherwise use them without permission.

Article 6 (Prohibited Acts)

Users must not engage in acts such as:

- Violating laws or public order.
- Criminal acts.
- Infringing intellectual property rights.
- Damaging or interfering with servers or networks.
- Commercial use of information obtained through the Service.
- Impersonation, unauthorized access, or other acts deemed inappropriate by the Company.

Articles 7–16 include provisions on suspension of service, usage restrictions, withdrawal, disclaimers, changes to service, amendments to Terms, handling of personal information, notifications, prohibition of rights transfer, and governing law (Japanese law applies; disputes under exclusive jurisdiction of the court at the Company's headquarters).
